Be part of a wild afternoon, learning about the only Cashmere Center in the world dedicated to the nomads of the India's High Himalayas.



Wild Fibers editor and publisher, Linda Cortright, will give a presentation on the Cashmere Center she built in Pangong India, (altitude 14,500'), dedicated to helping the women create value-added to the cashmere that is harvested from their goats.

Now entering its second-year of operation, the Center helps more than 80 nomadic women, spin, weave, and knit cashmere from the comfort of a passive solar-heated building made of rammed earth. The Center also provides a dedicated space for children to play safely.

In 2017, a special team of volunteers will spend one week working at the Center to help the women and their families.
